The [Evidence Use in Environmental Policymaking in Nigeria \(EUEPiN\)](#) project hosted by the [University of Lagos](#) hereby calls for applications for its 2nd cohort of participants for a capacity building workshop on Evidence-Informed Decision Making (EIDM) in environmental management.

This 2nd cohort builds on the achievements and outcomes of EUEPiN Project Cohort 1 titled “**Capacity Building and Establishment of a Community of Practice for Researchers and Policymakers for Evidence Use in Environmental Policymaking in Nigeria (alias EUEPiN)**”.

- Applicants should be **resident** and **affiliated** with a relevant **institution or organization in Nigeria**.

- Applicants should be fully available for the three (3) days in-person EUEPiN project capacity building workshop among others.

FUNDING AND BENEFITS

- A modest **transportation stipend, feeding** (breakfast, tea break and lunch) daily for the three (3) days of the workshop and **workshop materials** will be provided EXCEPT accommodation costs.
- A **Certificate of Participation** awarded by EUEPiN and AFIDEP will be given to participants who meet the workshop completion criteria.
- Participants who meet the workshop completion criteria will be **inducted** into the EUEPiN [Technical Work Groups](#) and [Community of Practice](#).
